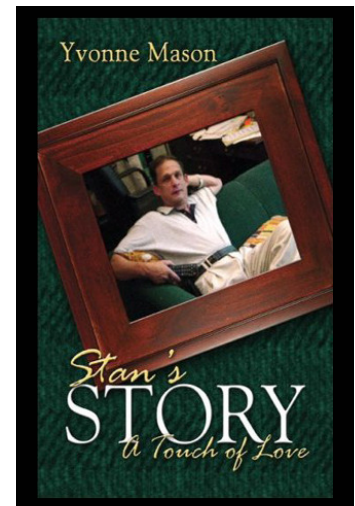

Q: Do you come up with your title (s) before or after you write the manuscript (s)? **A:** With Stan's Story, the title was originally A Touch of Love. That title came after I started writing. It seemed fitting for the man who is my hero. The Tangled Minds title came as the book was germinating in my creative mind. Brilliant Insanity was given to me by my publisher when he heard the story line. Silent Scream came as I was writing the book. The title came about because the victims were gagged and could only scream silently in their heads and hearts as they watched while one was killed and then while they were being killed. They now have a voice and it is heard.

Q: Tell us why you write the genre(s) that you write?

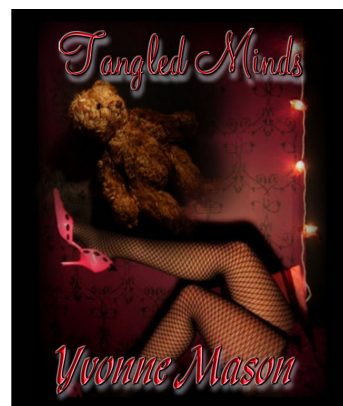
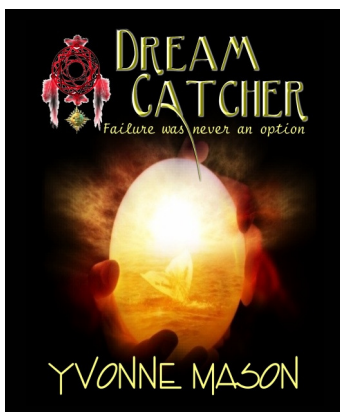
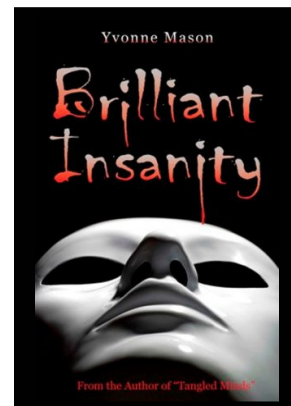
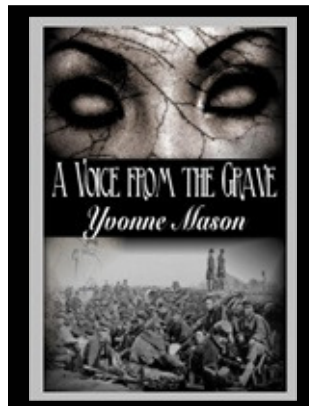
