Q: Tell us what makes you proud to be a writer from Blandon, PA?

A: Bullets and Bandages is dedicated to our Veterans. I am proud of my story; it reflects pride in our military and our people. I believe in the good of America and try to keep that in mind when I write.

Q: What or who inspired you to become a writer?

A: A combination of two things got me going. It was the tragedy of 911; it reinforced my sense of pride and patriotism. It was also my brother Patrick's stories about Vietnam. I had the information and the inspiration; the need to put it in words became clear.

Q: When did you begin writing with the intention of becoming published?

A: September 11, 2001

Q: Did your environment or upbringing play a major role in your writing and why? **A:** Yes, when I was 14 my brother went to Vietnam. I read his letters and watched the news about the war. I missed him and prayed to see him again. He was off to war and I was at home growing up in the Love and Peace generation. Bullets and Bandages is a reflection of that time in our history.

Q: Do you come up with your title (s) before or after you write the manuscript (s)? **A:** Before I started writing, when I sat there looking over my notes about Patrick's stories.

Q: Tell us why you write the genre (s) that you write?

A: I enjoy reading a good fictional story. Thrillers by Steven King, John Grisham, and Stuart Woods are some of my favorites. I guess that is why I like to write fiction as well. I also enjoy watching historical war movies and thrillers. I use my imagination to put into words what the reader can see and feel. In Fiction, the author creates his story. It is like an artist when he creates a painting.

Q: Tell us your most rewarding experience while in the writing process?

A: For me it is after the first draft is done. Then the fun begins as I go back over my work making the words flow. It is almost like I can see the words as they come to me. It is a rewarding experience to create something good and then make it better.

Q: Tell us your most negative experience while in the writing process?

A: I have had to learn Patience, Patience and more Patience. I also lost about three months of work when my computer got infected and my wife unknowingly erased my back up copy!

Q: Tell us your most rewarding experience in your publishing journey?

A: Without a doubt it was my presentation of Bullets and Bandages at the New Jersey Vietnam Veteran’s War Memorial. When I was signing books a disabled Veteran came over and I gave him a free copy. The look of satisfaction in his eyes, his happy face, it was awesome.

Q: Tell us your most negative experience in your publishing journey?

A: Trying to get book reviews. It took a lot----- of hard work to get where I am today.

Q: What one positive piece of advice would you give to other authors?

A: Choose your publisher carefully, do your homework before you hand over your story, and sign on the dotted line.

Q: Who Is Your Favorite Author?

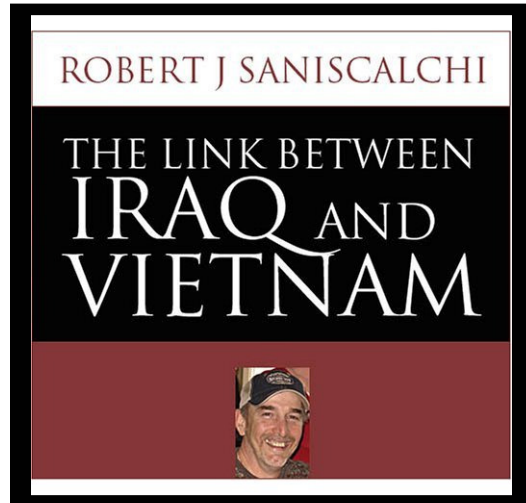
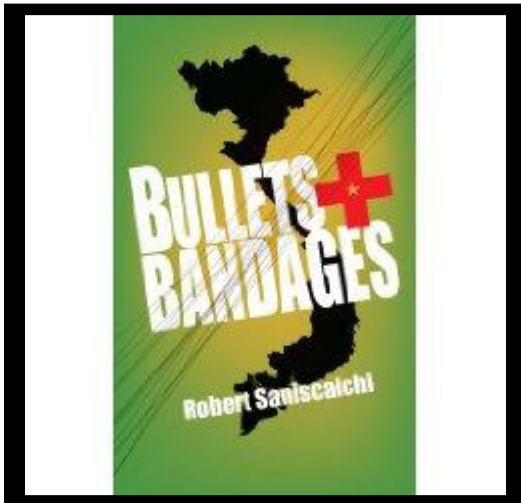
A: Steven King is the man.

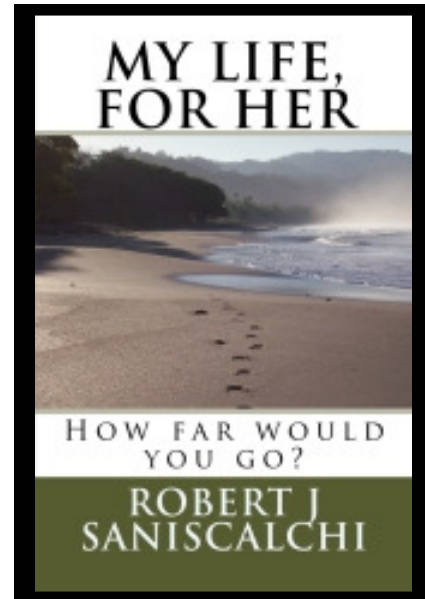
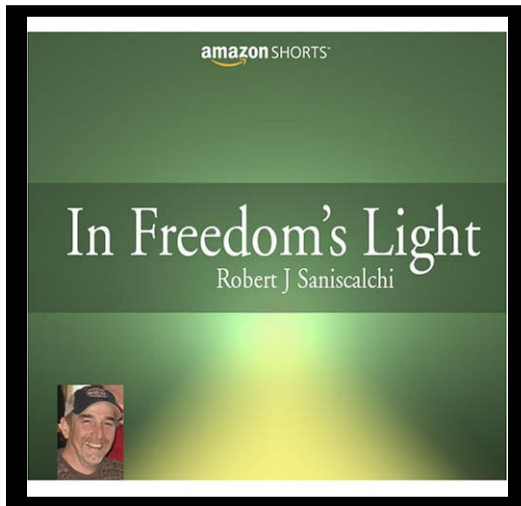
Q: What Format (s) are your books in: Print Only.....E-Book Only....or Both?
