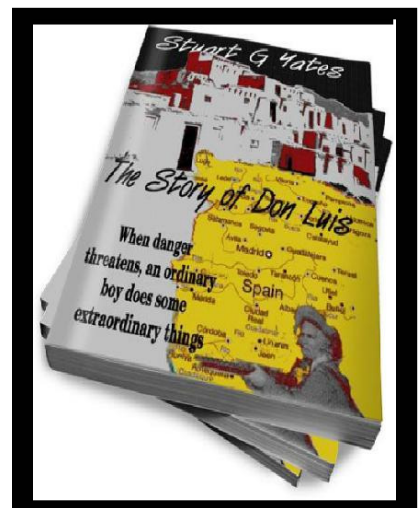


Books In Sync Is Featuring: [The Story of Don Luis](#) by [Stuart G. Yates](#)
