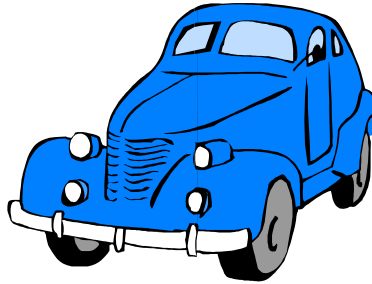


STUDEBAKER Editing Service
